We will have a booth at the upcoming Portland Boat show. We are looking for volunteers to fill 4 hour shifts. Look for the sign up sheet at the next meeting.

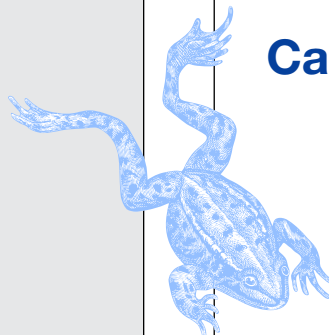
